This message is being sent with many important reminders for our Class of 2020 seniors.

First, please remember that tomorrow, Friday, May 15th is the day for senior item retrieval and drop off. A message was sent on Monday, May 4th with specific details. This information was also posted on our social media, website, and in all students Google classroom. Due to the volume of students it is important that students, arrive during their assigned window of time tomorrow:

7:30-9:00 A-C  
9:00-10:30 D-H  
10:30-11:30 I-L  
12:00-1:30 M-P  
1:30-3:00 Q-S  
3:00-4:30 T-Z

Seniors will be able to retrieve honor cords, a copy of the graduation program, and other miscellaneous items. Unfortunately, due to an issue with the vendor, senior yard signs will not be available at this time. As soon as we receive the yard signs, we will do another drive-through pick up for them.

Next, if seniors are using the TN Promise Scholarship to pay for college next year, they must watch a required webinar by tomorrow, Friday, May 15, or they will lose their TN Promise Scholarship.

Additionally, it is important that each senior complete the senior survey and request a final transcript by May 29th. Requesting a final transcript is important for all students, but specifically for students who are college bound as it is a requirement for college admission.
