Rossview High will have summer school available for any Rossview High student that has failed courses during their high school career. Students will be able to repeat as many credits as they can during the 2021 summer school session. Failed credits are courses in which the student's semester grade was below a 70. (This is for failed credits only. No new credits can be earned in summer school.)

When: Summer School will be held June 7 - July 16 from 7:30am - 1:30pm Monday through Thursday ONLY. Summer School is designed as a self-paced program. Once a student is notified of course completion, and have recovered the required credits, they are dismissed from summer school.

Deadline: Parents /Guardians must complete the registration form before 2:30pm on Friday, May 14th.

Transportation: Bus transportation will be available to students. Students choosing to utilize bus transportation will sign up on their registration form. Bus transportation will be provided from designated pick-up points. The pick-up points for Rossview High School are: Burt Elementary School, St. Bethlehem Elementary School, and Carmel Elementary School.
