Additionally, **Best in Show** awards are given to students who had the high score on a test regardless of level. Rossview scored highest on 5 of the tests:

- Danielle Smith: Latin 1 Grammar (42/50) and Hellenics (41/50)
- Wyatt Roder: Latin Literature (46/50), Latin 2 Reading Comprehension (19/20), and Roman Life (46/50)

Certamen is a quiz game played by three teams of up to four players, who answer questions about Latin, mythology, and Roman history & culture. Rossview's Latin 2 team (Wyatt Roder, Noah Clay, and Logan Graff) won 1st place with a dominant score of 140-0-0 in the finals out of a possible 150 points.

Wyatt Roder tied for first in the **Myth Spelling Bee** after going back and forth with his last opponent for an hour, exhausting the official word list and both being declared winners.
