Six Rossview students participated in the virtual 2021 National Junior Classical League convention. In academic contests, students are placed only against others in their level of Latin. The following students placed in the top 5 in the nation in academic testing.

**Wyatt Roder (Latin 2)**

1st - Latin Grammar, Mythology, Reading Comprehension, Latin Literature, Academic Heptathlon (7-subject test)

2nd - Latin Derivatives, Roman Life

3rd - Latin Vocabulary

5th - Roman History

Wyatt's five first places set a new Rossview record at Nationals!

Wyatt also competed as the sole representative of Tennessee in the intermediate level of Certamen, a quiz bowl game normally featuring three teams of four who buzz in to answer questions about Latin, history, mythology, and culture. Despite going it alone, Wyatt scored the most points of any team in the three preliminary rounds and entered the semifinals seeded #1. Unfortunately his run ended in the semis, but he finished fourth in the nation, an incredible accomplishment for an individual! Wyatt was deservedly named the Intermediate MVP.
