2021-2022 Schedules:

Schedules will be available on August 5th in PowerSchool. Students can view their schedules by going to the following website and entering their username and password: https://powerschool.cmcss.net

Drivers' Permit:

- Must fill out an SF-1010 form, these can be picked up in the front office.
- After filling out the form, the front office assistants will check for the following State of Tennessee Requirements:
 - Student must be at least 15 years of age
 - Students must pass more than half of their courses during the previous semester
 - Students must have fewer than 15 non-consecutive unexcused absences and/or days of suspension during the previous semester OR fewer than 10 consecutive unexcused absences and/or days of suspension during the previous semester.
- When the student's form is ready, they will be notified when to pick up in the front office.
- Please allow 24 hours to process.
- Forms are valid for 30 days from the date. When expired, students will have to complete the process again.
- **If students owe any fees (books, laptops, charger, etc). They will not receive an SF1010 form until these fees are paid. **

Schedule Corrections:

Schedule corrections are made during the FIRST 10 DAYS OF SCHOOL for the following reasons only:

- A class is missing from the schedule
- Required prerequisite has not been met
- A failed course needs to be repeated
- Course was passed or already repeated
- There is a blank period in the schedule

As a reminder, students enrolled in AP and Honors classes are expected to remain in the selected classes as stipulated in the AP or Honors contract. Students meeting one of the criteria above should click the link below.

- POWERSCHOOL MOBILE APP: The PowerSchool app is a free and convenient resource for families to review their child's academic progress. Once you set up an account using the directions above, download the app from the App Store or Google Play. Use CMCSS' district code P Z Q N when you register.

- SCHOOLMESSENGER TEXT ALERTS: Once you're registered in PowerSchool, text (Y) to (67587) and opt-in to mobile messaging. * Messaging and data rates may apply.

• <u>Football Season Tickets: https://gofan.co/app/events/358300</u> Here is your link for 2021 Rossview Home Football Schedule. These tickets are good to ALL games (Varsity, JV, Frosh), which are hosted by RHS. The price

is \$35 plus a 3.75 convenience fee.(38.75). We have a limited supply of these. These tickets are for family members. A family can purchase up to a maximum of eight family passes. (Non-school age children do not need a ticket at RHS). If we reduce capacity, (see covid last year), season ticket holders are the first people in the stadium. Please be aware we cannot control weather and covid in regards to a cancellation. Once again these are regular season tickets only. Any playoff or bowl game will be an additional fee. This season ticket does not apply to Jr. Pro or Middle School when these games take place at RHS.
