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Student Parking Passes:

Student Parking Pass Applications will be available to pick up in the Main Office, the SRO's office, or in the Cafeteria during lunch period. A parking pass costs \$20.00 payable either by cash or check made out to Rossview High School. Along with a completed parking application, students will need proof of driver's license, registration, and up-to-date insurance. Parking passes will be sold on the following days.

Drivers' Permit:

- Must fill out an SF-1010 form, these can be picked up in the front office.
- After filling out the form, the front office assistants will check for the following State of Tennessee Requirements:
 - Student must be at least 15 years of age
 - Students must pass more than half of their courses during the previous semester
 - Students must have fewer than 15 non-consecutive unexcused absences and/or days of suspension during the previous semester OR fewer than 10 consecutive unexcused absences and/or days of suspension during the previous semester.
- When the student's form is ready, they will be notified when to pick up in the front office.
- Please allow 24 hours to process.
- Forms are valid for 30 days from the date. When expired, students will have to complete the process again.
- ****If students owe any fees (books, laptops, charger, etc). They will not receive an SF1010 form until these fees are paid. ****

- A failed course needs to be repeated
- Course was passed or already repeated
- There is a blank period in the schedule

Staying connected with communications from RHS and the district:

CMCSS families are encouraged to sign up for PowerSchool and School Messenger notifications. These are the primary means of communication from both school-based administrators and the district. Families will receive everything from inclement weather messages to instruction updates. You can download the PowerSchool Mobile app (free) on any Android or iOS device, including Apple Watch, and sign up for text alerts, too.

- **CREATING A POWERSCHOOL ACCOUNT:** To create a PowerSchool account, visit powerschool.cmcss.net, click the Create Account tab, and complete the form. If you do not know the Access ID for your child (ren), please contact your child(ren)'s school(s).
- **POWERSCHOOL MOBILE APP:** The PowerSchool app is a free and convenient resource for families to review their child's academic progress. Once you set up an account using the directions above, download the app from the App Store or Google Play. Use CMCSS' district code P Z Q N when you register.
- **SCHOOLMESSENGER TEXT ALERTS:** Once you're registered in PowerSchool, text (Y) to (67587) and opt-in to mobile messaging. * Messaging and data rates may apply.
- **UPDATE YOUR CONTACT INFORMATION:** Throughout the year, if a parent or guardian needs to update his or her contact information, please visit CMCSS Parent Self-Service and click the "Update Student Information" tile to enter new contact information.

Reminder for Back to School Shopping: CMCSS Dress Code

The dress code is designed to ensure the health and safety of students and to avoid distractions to the educational process, while preserving the basic rights of individuals. The following guidelines must be followed:

1. Attire must not be destructive to school property (i.e. body chains, spikes).
2. Dress must comply with the health and safety codes, regulations, and recommendations of the State of Tennessee and federal health agencies.
3. Dress or appearance must not interfere with the educational process or the rights of others.
 - a. Hats, caps, hoods, and distracting headwear are prohibited inside buildings during school hours.
 - b. Sunglasses are prohibited inside buildings unless prescribed.
 - c. Bare midriffs, see-through garments, undergarment type shirts, bare backs, halter tops, low-cut blouses and pants, mini-skirts, tank tops, cut-offs, and pajama pants are prohibited.
 - d. Shorts, in appropriate lengths and materials, are permitted in grades K-12. No spandex or brief type shorts are permitted.
 - e. Leggings are permissible as long as they are not see-through.
 - f. Skirts and dresses must be longer than mid-thigh.
 - g. Obscene, profane, provocative, violent, or inflammatory words or pictures on body/skin, clothing or jewelry, or clothing advertising alcoholic beverages, drugs, drug paraphernalia or tobacco products are prohibited.
 - h. Students in grades 6-12 are prohibited from wearing, while on school property or at any school-sponsored activity, any type of clothing, apparel, or accessory, which denotes such students' membership in or affiliation with any gang (T.C.A. § 49-6-4215).
 - i. Extremely low-riding pants are not allowed because they are a safety hazard. "Sagging" is not permitted.
 - j. Body piercings shall not distract from the instructional process.
 - k. Jewelry ornaments or accessories which distract from the educational process or which present a safety concern will not be allowed (i.e. grills).
 - l. Clothes worn with holes above mid-thigh must have garment worn beneath them.
 - m. Standard footwear including shoes, boots, athletic shoes, and or sandals must be worn. House shoes or skate shoes will not be allowed.
