7 of our wrestlers finished their season by achieving All State status and placing top 6 in the state at their wrestling weight class.

Congratulations to 2022 TSSAA State Wrestling Medalist: Gabriela Wilkinson- 3rd in the State. Analise Jetter- 4th in the state. Alyssa Adamo- 5th in the state. Alexis Mize- 5th in the state Katelyn McMillan- 5th in the state

Sammy Shires- The State Champion. Was voted the Most Outstanding Wrestler in the state of TN across all weight divisions. Finishes his season at 59-0. Is only the 2nd male wrestler to ever win a state championship in the history of Rossview.

Zack Duessler- State Runner-Up. Finishes his season at 55-5. Is only the 5th male wrestler in the history of Rossview to make it to the state championship match.

Coach Price- was awarded as the TN Girls Wrestling coach of the year, and the NWCA National Sectional (Southeast US) coach of the year.

Graduation Information for Seniors:

Graduation Attire

- Option #1: White-collared dress shirt, black tie or bow ties with no pattern (no western bolos), black dress slacks, and black dress shoes. No tennis shoes, crocs or shoes with patterns! If any of these items are an issue, see your guidance counselor, Dr. Herndon, or Dr. Sanders.
- Option #2: Dress or skirt of any color (should not be longer than your graduation gown) and black close-toed shoes. When your foot is in the shoe, your entire foot, including your heel, must be covered. No flip flops, crocs, floppy heels, dressy sandals, goliath sandals, or anything that shows any part of your foot except the top. You will need bobby pins for your graduation cap. If any of these items are an issue, see your guidance counselor, Dr. Herndon, or Dr. Sanders
- All graduates: Graduation caps are worn flat on the top of your head, not on the back of your head. NOTHING IS TO BE WRITTEN ON YOUR GRADUATION CAP! When you pick up your gown, hang it up to remove the wrinkles. Do not iron your graduation gown.
- Your attire will be checked by faculty members as you enter the Dunn Center. If you are not dressed according to the dress code, you will not be permitted to walk.
- Masks are optional, but should be a solid color.

Guest Ticket Information

- Each student will receive a maximum of ten (10) guest tickets.
- EVERYONE must have a ticket to be admitted. This includes minor children.
- NO STUDENT WILL BE GIVEN MORE THAN TEN (10) TICKETS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.
- *Please be aware that if we have to change the location of our graduation ceremonies, the number of guests that will be allowed to attend may significantly decrease. This is not likely, but possible.

Guest Guidelines for Graduation (Per Austin Peay State University)

- Those who plan to attend graduation must be able to affirm the following:
 - They have not been in close contact with a confirmed case of Covid-19 in the last fourteen (14) days. *This does not apply to medical professionals, first responders, or other individuals who encounter COVID-19 as part of their professional or caregiving duties while wearing appropriate PPE.
- Every guest entering the Dunn Center, regardless of age, must have a ticket.
- Every guest entering the Dunn Center, regardless of age, must sit in their designated seat.
- Guests will not be allowed on the Dunn Center floor before, during, and after the ceremony.
- Guests should enter the Dunn Center through the entrance designated on the front of their admission ticket. The doors will open one (1) hour prior to the start of the ceremony.

Additional Information

- Absolutely no "air horns" or disruptive devices will be tolerated during the graduation ceremony. Any disruptive attendants will be escorted from the building by law enforcement.
- Austin Peay offers a free live webcast of each commitment ceremony. A link to the webcast will be available on the commencement webpage within 24 hours of each ceremony. Commencement is also aired live on CDE Lightband Channel 9, Spectrum Cable Channel 192, and AT&T Uverse Channel 99. It can also be heard on WAPX-FM radio, 91.9 MHZ. We are delighted that family members from anywhere in the world will be able to hear their loved one's name called during this important event.

After School Credit Recovery

If your student failed an academic course & would like to make it up, after school credit recovery will be staring Jan 31. Contracts available in guidance or from your teacher now. After School Credit Recovery is a program that allows students the opportunity to regain lost credits in one or more core academic courses by completing assigned course work online. Math and science credit recovery meets after school on Mondays and Tuesdays and English and social studies credit recovery meets on Wednesdays and Thursdays. All credit recovery is from 2:30-4:30 pm and transportation is not provided. To register for credit recovery, students will pick up a contract from their teacher or from guidance and return to the guidance office. Spots are filled in the order completed contracts are returned to guidance.

Visitors in the Front office

Dismissing Students

In order for a student to be dismissed, the following must be done:

- A student brings a hand-written parent note in the morning of the school day they need to be dismissed. The note MUST have guardian's name giving permission, phone number, and time the student is to be dismissed.
- Parent/Guardian comes into the front office with their driver's license to check the student out.
- NOT acceptable for dismissal:
 - Phone calls
 - Emails
 - Faxes
 - Self-dismiss

Drivers' Permit:

- Must fill out an SF-1010 form, these can be picked up in the front office.
- After filling out the form, the front office assistants will check for the following State of Tennessee Requirements:
 - Student must be at least 15 years of age
 - Students must pass more than half of their courses during the previous semester
 - Students must have fewer than 15 non-consecutive unexcused absences and/or days of suspension during the previous semester OR fewer than 10 consecutive unexcused absences and/or days of suspension during the previous semester.
- When the student's form is ready, they will be notified when to pick up in the front office.
- Please allow 24 hours to process.
- Forms are valid for 30 days from the date. When expired, students will have to complete the process again.
- **If students owe any fees (books, laptops, charger, etc). They will not receive an SF1010 form until these fees are paid. **
