- **REGULAR**: 22 CREDITS
- HONORS: ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR A REGULAR DIPLOMA, 85% CUMULATIVE PERCENT AVERAGE, NO SEMESTER GRADE LOWER THAN A 75, AND MEET ACT BENCHMARKS
 - ACT BENCHMARKS: ENGLISH 18 MATH 22 READING 22 SCIENCE 23
- <u>HIGHEST HONORS:</u> ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR AN HONORS DIPLOMA, **90**% CUMULATIVE PERCENT AVERAGE, NO SEMESTER GRADE LOWER THAN A **75**, MEET ACT BENCHMARKS AND MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
 - ACT BENCHMARKS: ENGLISH 18 MATH 22 READING 22 SCIENCE 23

HIGHEST HONORS MUST INCLUDE:

- 2 AP CLASSES (ONE MUST BE FROM CORE-ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES)
