# DIPLOMA TYPES

- **REGULAR**: 22 CREDITS
- **HONORS**: ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR A REGULAR DIPLOMA, 85% CUMULATIVE PERCENT AVERAGE, NO SEMESTER GRADE LOWER THAN A 75, AND MEET ACT BENCHMARKS
  - **ACT BENCHMARKS**: ENGLISH 18 • MATH 22 • READING 22 • SCIENCE 23
- **HIGHEST HONORS**: ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR AN HONORS DIPLOMA, 90% CUMULATIVE PERCENT AVERAGE, NO SEMESTER GRADE LOWER THAN A 75, MEET ACT BENCHMARKS AND MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:
  - **ACT BENCHMARKS**: ENGLISH 18 • MATH 22 • READING 22 • SCIENCE 23

# HIGHEST HONORS MUST INCLUDE:

- 2 AP CLASSES (ONE MUST BE FROM CORE-ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE, SOCIAL STUDIES)
- 4 MATH - ALGEBRA 1, ALGEBRA 2, GEOMETRY, AND ONE MORE HIGHER LEVEL MATH (BRIDGE MATH DOES NOT MEET THIS CRITERIA)
- 3 SCIENCE TO INCLUDE BIOLOGY AND TWO OF THE FOLLOWING: CHEMISTRY, PHYSICS, ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY, AP BIOLOGY, AP CHEMISTRY, AP PHYSICS, AP ENVIRONMENTAL
- 2 YEARS OF THE SAME WORLD LANGUAGE
- 4 ENGLISH TO INCLUDE HONORS LEVEL IN 10<sup>TH</sup>, 11<sup>TH</sup>, 12<sup>TH</sup>
